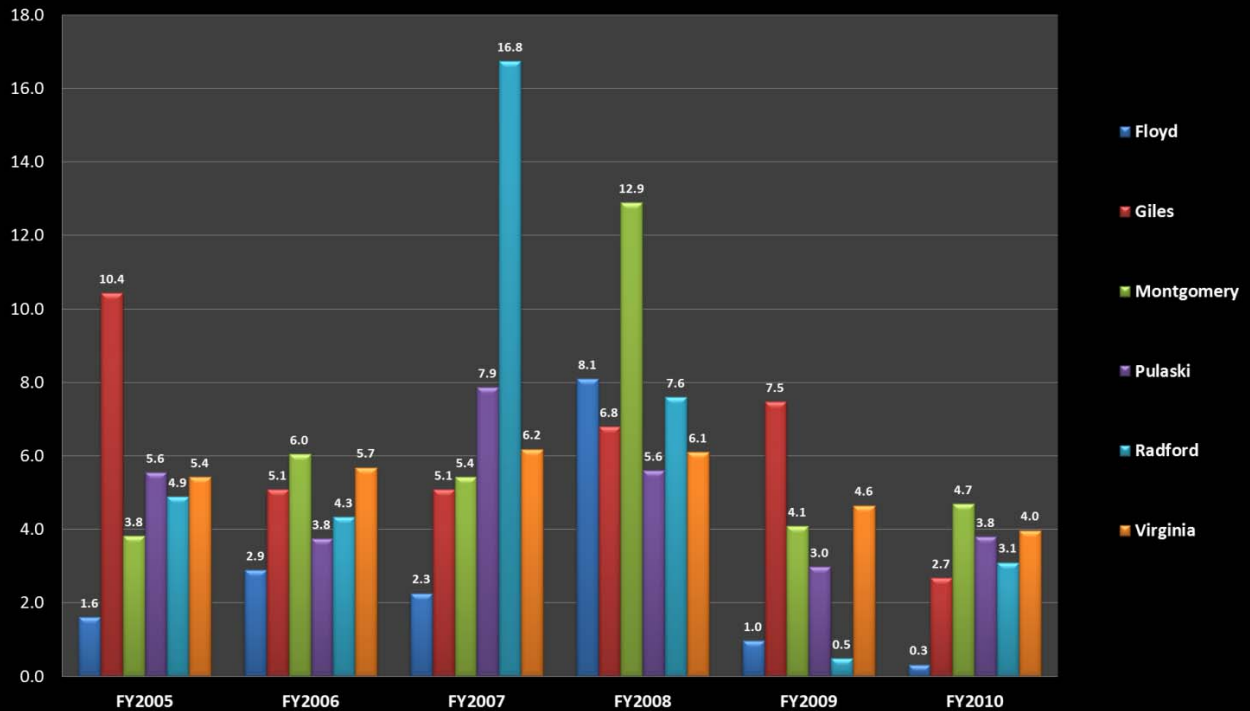


### Intake Complaints Related to Disorderly Conduct & Vandalism

**What this means:** Three of five jurisdictions in the NRV experienced **increases** in the number of intake complaints related to disorderly conduct from FY 2009 to FY 2010. Radford City's rate of disorderly conduct intakes, including vandalism actually **increased** by 520%. The state of Virginia (at 4.0) reported a 13% decrease; however, this number is still higher than the NRV average of 2.92.
