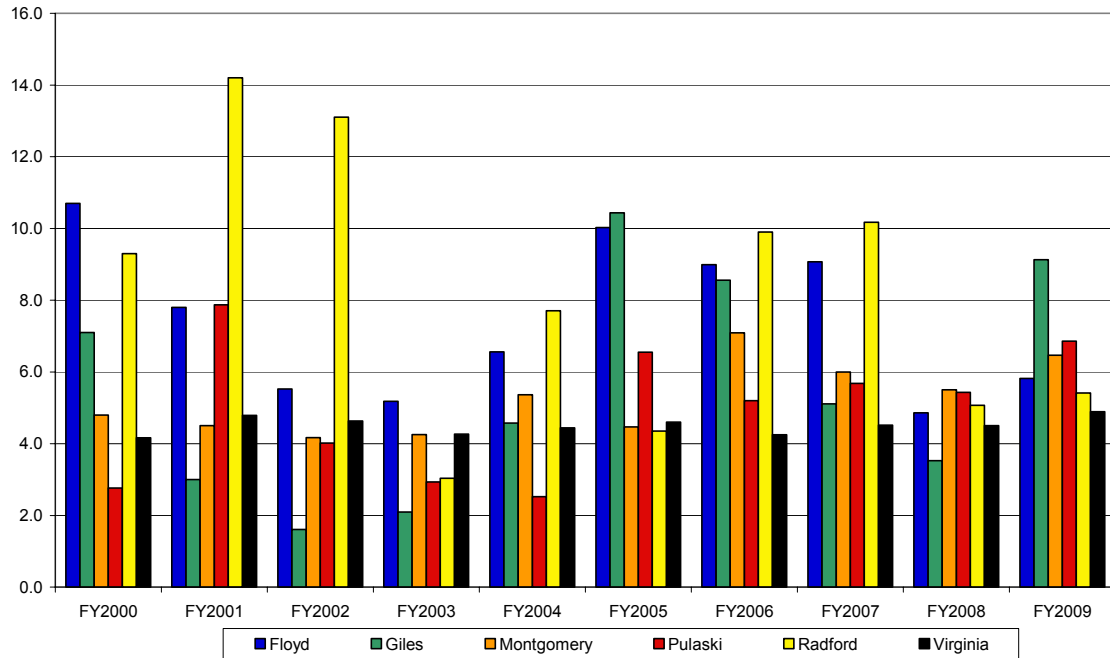

What this means: All five jurisdictions in the NRV and the state of Virginia saw an **increase** in the number of intake complaints related to alcohol, tobacco and other drugs from FY 2008 to FY 2009, with Giles County showing a substantial increase in ATOD intakes. The NRV average of 6.7 is **higher than the state average** of 4.9. Despite increases in the NRV, **decreases** were reported nationally in the use of methamphetamines, alcohol, cigarettes, amphetamines and cocaine. For more information please visit:
