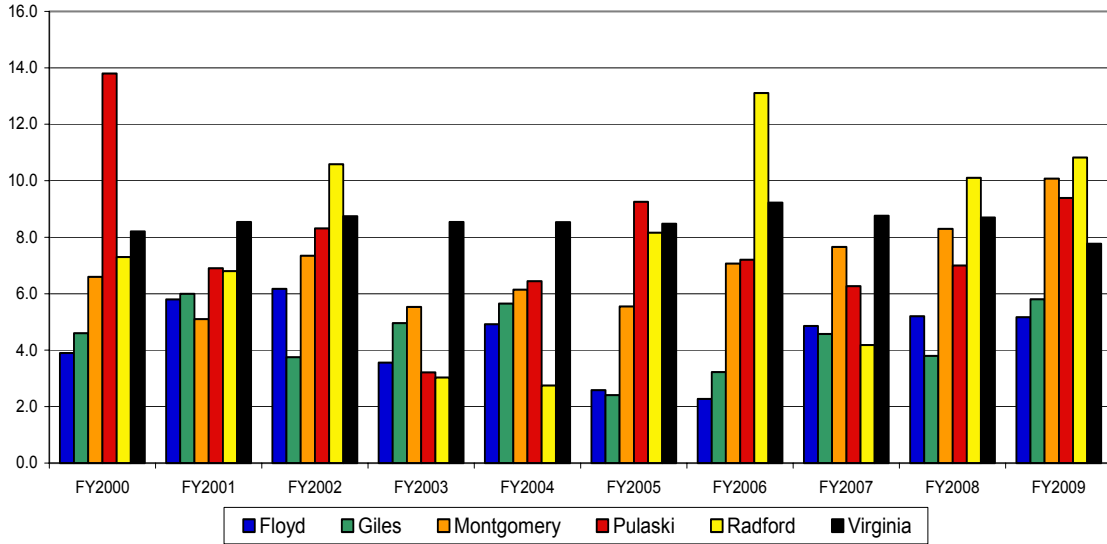

### Intake Complaints Related to Violence

**What this means:** Four out of five jurisdictions in the NRV experienced **increases** in the number of intake complaints related to violence from FY 2008 to FY 2009, which includes assault, robbery, sexual assault, murder, and manslaughter. Floyd County reported no change. Despite increases in the NRV, the total number of violence intakes for Virginia **decreased** 10%; The Virginia rate of 7.8 is **lower** than the NRV average of 8.3.
