






October is here and many individuals are looking forward to celebrating Halloween or other autumnthemed events. However, Halloween can be stressful and demanding for many.

Halloween Sensory Slime

Supplies needed:

- Clear glue, glitter glue or white glue (Elmer's washable works best but dollar store is ok too!)
- Liquid Starch
- Water
- Measuring Cup
- 2 bowls and a spoon
- Food coloring, confetti, glitter (optional)

Steps:

- 1. In one bowl mix 1/2 cup water and 1/2 cup of glue {really mix to combine completely}.
