Summary & Purpose:

NRVCS is requesting bids for an entity that can facilitate a training program that will result in the credentialing of no less than two staff members in the evidence-based practice of A-CRA.

Scope of Project:

Vendor shall provide:

- 1. Bids that will encompass the total cost of services.
- 2. Access to research-based trainings in CRA/A-CRA.
- 3. An interactive virtual workshop consisting of live instruction, video / audio recordings, demonstrations, and small group practice.
- 4. Training material and operational material designed to credential clinical staff seeking to provide CRA/A-CRA treatment.
- Training material and operational material that are designed to credential clinical staff seeking to provide training and supervision to clinicians implementing CRA/A-CRA.
- 6. Provide post-training electronic courses for use of CRA/A-CRA with co-occurring disorders.
- 7. Provide coaching for a period post certification of the staff.

8. Access to technical assistance.

Expectations of Contractor:

- 1. The contractor should have three years or more experience providing this service as described in the scope of project.
- 2. The contractor will certify two practitioners of A-CRA, one of which will be certified as a trainer / supervisor.
- 3. The contractor will have the ability to facilitate the credentialing process virtually.

Timeline:

Proposals must specify the expected timeline for credentialling and offer several training dates, once awarded to the selected contractor for start date and completion.
